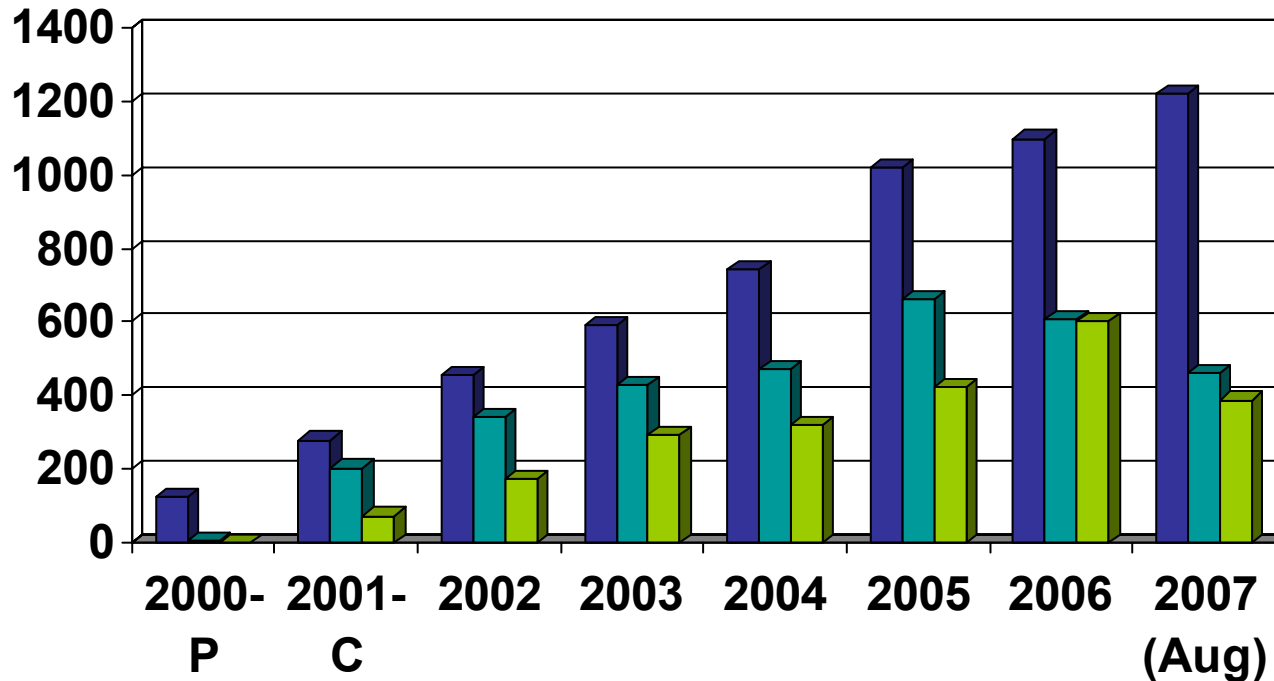

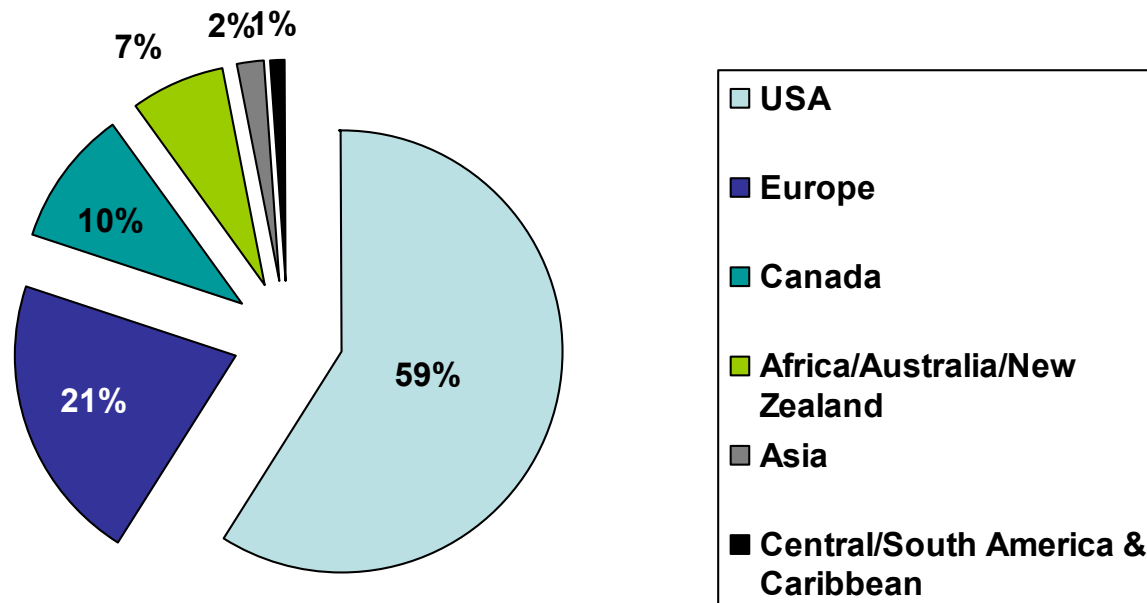
## TPSIG Membership Growth
